He also wrote, produced, and directed the New York Comedy Film Festival Best Feature award winning indie, “Good Money,” and produced the original musical, “Having It Almost.”

Jeremiah holds an undergraduate degree from the University of Chicago and certification from UCLA’s Anderson School of Management Executive Program.
