What's Happening at the Preserve? TV stars, Mansions, and Events!

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION! Filming at the Preserve



With its diverse outdoor environments and ample indoor space, the Preserve is a popular location for film and television productions. Most recently, HBO's *The*

Gilded Age returned for another season of transforming the Hempstead House library into the office of main character, George Russell. Also filmed recently was CBS's FBI, which used multiple locations on our grounds to create a fictitious military academy. These episodes will air soon – look for us on TV!

PROTECTING HEMPSTEAD HOUSE Repairing a Century-Old Building



Over 100 years old, Hempstead House is an iconic Gatsby-era mansion. Built at the turn of the 20th century, it served as a summer home to Daniel and Florence Guggenheim in the 1920s and 30s, a temporary refuge for children displaced by World War II in the 1940s, and a laboratory for special weapons development and testing in the 1950s and 60s. Unfortunately, this historic treasure has fallen victim to the effects of weather and age. Leaky roofs and broken façade stones are among our current restoration projects. In the coming months, thanks in part to grant funding from New York State and the financial support from our members and friends, the Conservancy will be able to continue its mission to preserve the precious treasure that is Hempstead House.
